Information We Collect

AIRV may collect limited information to support platform functionality and program improvement, including:

- Basic user-provided information (e.g., name, email, affiliation)
- Usage and engagement data (e.g., tool usage frequency, anonymized interaction metrics)
- Voluntary feedback and survey responses

AIRV does **not** intentionally collect sensitive personal data such as Social Security numbers, financial account details, or medical records.

How We Use Information
